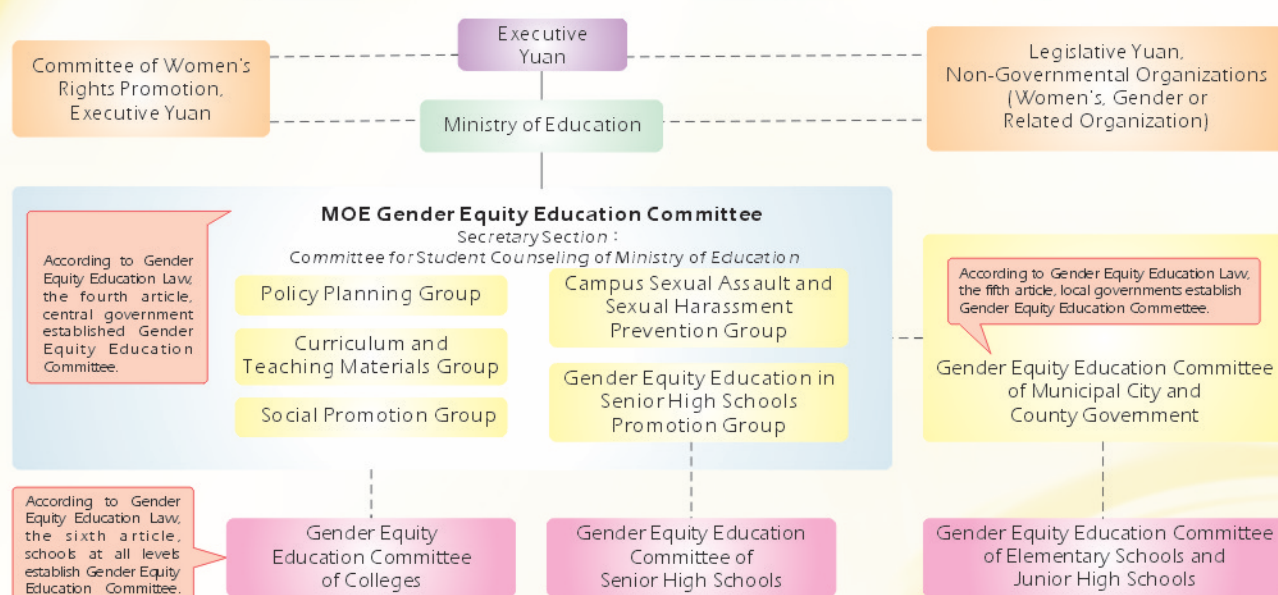


History and Mission of Gender Equity Education Committee

To promote the conviction of gender equality education, Ministry of Education in Taiwan had established “Gender Equality Education Committee” in March, 1997. After functioning for six years, in order to improve gender equity, to eliminate gender discrimination, and to protect everyone's self-esteem, the Ministry of Education in Taiwan reformed and established “Gender Equity Education Committee, Ministry of Education” based on Gender Equity Education Law, the fourth article, which is proclaimed and enforced on June 23rd, 2004. It endeavors to promote gender equity education not only on campus but also in society, and to enable each person to enjoy the rights of gender equity!

Basis for the Structure of the Committee



Five Sub-groups of Gender Equity Education Committee

Policy Planning Group: Draft related policies of gender equity education, promote the concept of gender equity education, as well as supervise and evaluate the achievements of gender equity education.

Curriculum and Teaching Materials Group: Develop the curriculum and teaching materials on gender equity education, and evaluate teaching effects.

Social Promotion Group: Use media, such as “Gender Equity Education Quarterly,” and the website of Gender Equity Education, Ministry of Education, to promote familial and social gender equity education.

Campus Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment Prevention Group: Establish procedure and mechanism to supervise and assist in investigations and prosecutions based on “Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment Prevention Regulations.”

Gender Equity Education in Senior High Schools Promotion Group: Assist Ministry of Education Central Region Office and other Senior High Schools in promoting gender equity education, and providing counseling services.
